## ELIGIBILITY FOR GNM COURSE

- ❁ Only female candidates possessing good health and moral character are considered for the course.
- ❁ Age shall be 17 years to 35 years.
- ❁ Minimum Higher Secondary (10+2) pass or equivalent examination from recognized boards (WBCHSE/CBSE/ISC/NIOS/RMVS) and with minimum of 40% marks in aggregate of compulsory subjects and minimum of 40% marks in English.
- ❁ Resident of West Bengal (uninterrupted stay in the State for minimum of five years prior to application).
- ❁ The applicant must be medically fit and mentally alert.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR B.SC NURSING COURSE

- ❁ Only female candidates possessing good health and moral character are considered for the course.
- ❁ Age shall be 17 years.
- ❁ Minimum Higher Secondary (10+2) pass or equivalent examination from recognized boards (WBCHSE/CBSE/ISC/NIOS/RMVS) with science (PCB) & English with aggregate of 45% marks.
- ❁ Resident of West Bengal (uninterrupted stay in the State for minimum of five years prior to application).
- ❁ The applicant must be medically fit and mentally alert.

## THE CURRICULUM

- ❁ GNM & B.Sc (Nsg) Course will commence as declaration by WBNC & WBUHS.. Syllabus prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and the regulations prescribed by the West Bengal Nursing Council (WBNC) are followed.  
After admission all the candidates are required to be registered with the West Bengal Nursing Council & WBUHS as Student Nurse.
- ❁ All Clinical Experience and Field visits both in Ballavpur/Sattore and outside are compulsory for the students.

## EXAMINATION GUIDELINES :

1. Shall have one regular examination followed by supplementary examination in a year.
2. If a candidate fails, they can be promoted to next year.
3. A candidate take any number of attempts with a condition that maximum period allowed in 6 years. However all previous papers need to be cleared before. Appearing in the final examination.
4. Minimum pass marks should be 50% in each of the Theory and Practical papers separately.
5. Minimum pass marks shall be 40% for English only.
6. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical examination separately in each of the papers.
7. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper, she has to re-appear for both the papers ( Theory and Practical).

## ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION :

A candidate shall be eligible for the admission to the State Council/Board Examination if the Principal of the Institution certifies that :

- a. She has completed not less than eleven months of the course.
- b. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance ( irrespective of the kind of absence ) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.  
The diploma shall not be awarded to the student till she has completed the clinical/field requirements.
- c. A candidate must secure 50% marks in internal assessment separately in each theory and practical.
- d. The record of practical experience is complete.

THE CANDIDATES REPEATING SAME YEAR OF STUDIES AFTER FAILURE WILL HAVE TO PAY FULL TUTION FEE AND MESS CHARGES FOR THE WHOLE YEAR.
